## **ARGA 2012 Conference: Student Bursaries**

All students who are making a presentation (oral or poster) at the ARGA 2012 Conference are eligible for a student bursary to assist with travel and accommodation. The awarding of bursaries is a competitive process based on the content of the extended abstract submitted. The student should be the first or sole author of the extended abstract.

The value of a bursary will be based on (but not necessarily equal to) the value of a return air fare for the student from their home institution within Australia or New Zealand. To be eligible for a bursary the extended abstract should be submitted before December 14 2011. Students should submit an application form for the ARGA 2012 Conference Student Bursary at the time of submitting their abstract. Verification of student status must also be supplied at the time of submitting the abstract.

Successful applicants for the ARGA 2012 Conference Student Bursaries will be notified on or before the 7<sup>th</sup> of January 2012. The decision of the ARGA Management Committee in regard to the allocation of bursaries will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
